*Attested Originals of documents from Sl. No. 1-8 should be presented during the time of interview for verification.

*Students who have obtained their bachelors or masters from India or any other country, the respective documents should be Apostile / Attested from the Ministry of External Affairs, India or the country from which it is obtained.

*Students who have previously studied in India have to invariably submit copies of all the FRRO documents covering their entire stay in India.
